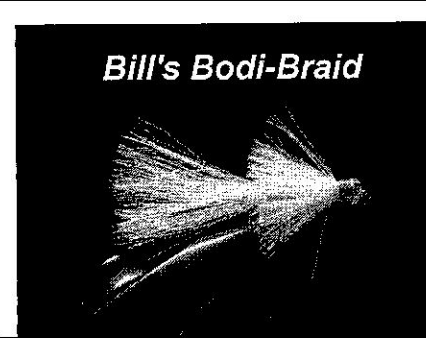


Tying the "(Deadly Shiner) Goldie"

Bill's Bodi-Braid



Materials:

Hook - Mustad #3906B Size #6-#16 (Best size - 3906B #8 w/ 5/32" Tungston bead, gold or gold nickle or silver)

Beads - Raymond C. Rumpf Tungston Beads

Gold fly = Gold Bead

Silver fly = Silver Bead or Gold Bead

Pearl fly = Gold or Silver Bead (Mylar to match Bead color)

Copper fly = Copper Bead w/Gold Mylar body

Tail & Body Veil - Bill's Bodi-Braid in Gold, Silver, Pearl or Copper (5-6 Strands picked out)

Threads - Danville's "A" Fly Master + Unwaxed
Unithread 6/0 White or Fire Orange

Mylar - Gold or Silver #14-#12 (#10 on Size #6-8)

Tail Flash - Red Krystal Flash

Adhesive - "Quick Tite" super glue

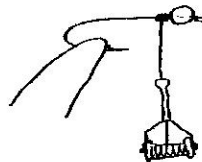
This fly works well on, Brookies, Rainbows, Browns, Perch, Calico Bass, Large & Small Mouth Bass, as well as Blue Gills. Tie a few in larger sizes on Salt Water hooks for Stripers, Blues and Albies.

STEP 1



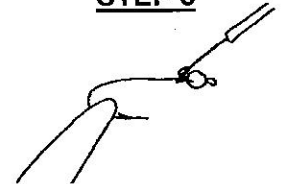
Open hook Gape slightly

STEP 2



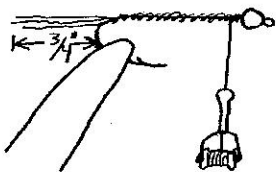
Put Bead on Hook

STEP 3



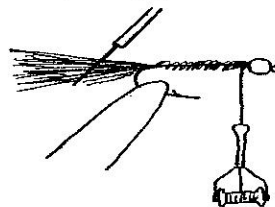
Ad Quick Tite glue

STEP 4



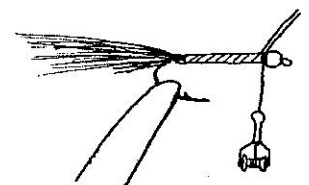
3-4 Strands Red Krystal Flash 3/4"

STEP 5



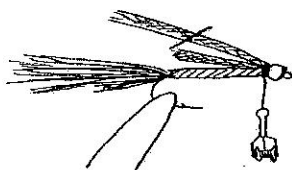
Tie on tail loops, cut & pick out w/Bodkin. Tail length = 1 1/4 hook length

STEP 6



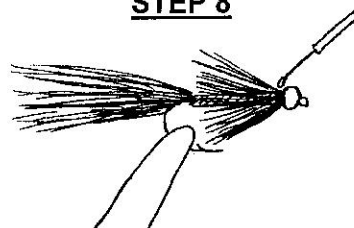
Ad Mylar body

STEP 7



Tie on Braid loops ending at hook, cut loops and pick out w/Bodkin

STEP 8



Finish Veil & apply Head Cement
